

## FLIGHT OPERATIONS SAFETY RULES

Renter, by affixing his/her signature hereon, does agree to follow the following flight operations safety rules, emergency maintenance procedures, and insurance provisions.

- A. Pilot Certificate – Renter must hold a valid and current pilot certificate with appropriate ratings. The person named on the rental contract shall be the pilot in command. The Renter will fly the Aircraft from the left seat and he/she will be responsible for the Aircraft and its operation at all times.
- B. Currency – Renter must possess evidence of a current biennial flight review (BFR), medical certificate and aircraft checkout by a pilot designated by Purdue Aviation. If the Renter has not flown a Purdue Aviation aircraft of the same category and class in the preceding 90 days (60 days in the Piper Seneca), the Renter will be required to complete a checkout with a Purdue Aviation CFI.
- C. Preflight – Renter will personally conduct a preflight inspection of the Aircraft as prescribed by the manufacturer. Renter shall use the manufacturer’s recommended pre-takeoff, cruise and pre-landing checklists.
- D. Weather – Renter shall operate the Aircraft only when the present and forecasted weather indicates VFR conditions throughout the flight unless Renter is instrument rated, current for IFR and specifically approved by Purdue Aviation for IFR flight.
- E. Airports – Renter agrees that no take-off or landing shall be made on any area other than the runways of an airport designed, constructed, maintained, and used as an airport with PAVED runways of no less than 3,000 feet unless accompanied by a certified flight instructor or approved by the chief instructor or flight school manager. The Renter agrees not to fly to or from or to land or take-off from grass or unimproved fields. The Renter understands and agrees that a failure to comply with this provision voids insurance coverage that may otherwise apply.
- F. Physical Status of Renter – Renter shall not operate the Aircraft under the influence of any non-FAA approved medication or substance. Additionally, Renter shall not operate the Aircraft for a period of at least 12 hours after using or if still under the influence of intoxicating substances such as alcohol, tranquilizers, and sleeping aids.
- G. The Renter agrees to not fly with less than one hour fuel reserves.
- H. The Renter will comply with all local, state and federal regulations.
- I. The Renter agrees to not fly in formation flight.

J. The use of the Aircraft outside the Continental United States must be approved by Chief Flight Instructor or Flight School Manager.

K. Flight instruction by anyone other than Purdue Aviation, LLC employees is PROHIBITED!
