



Purdue Aviation offers our Initial CFI ground school each semester that runs for two months, meeting twice a week for two hours at a time. The class is limited in numbers of students, each of which will be presenting topics at each meeting; the topics are the CFI PTS elements that each require lesson plans. The cost of this course is \$745 that includes 32 hours of classroom instruction and much of the required materials; after completing the lesson plans, and passing the FOI and FIA exams, graduates receive the CFI ground training endorsement required for the CFI practical examination. The graduates who elect to complete their flight training with us will fly six to ten flights with a CFI who is qualified to train initial CFI candidates at a cost of around \$200 per flight hour, depending on the choice of aircraft.

The Fall semester classes run from approximately mid-September to mid-November. The Spring semester classes run from approximately mid-February to mid-April. The Summer semester classes run from approximately mid-June to mid-August.

A Maymester class may be offered if sufficient interest exists, it runs concurrently with Purdue's Maymester and we will not meet when the University classes are not in session. This class meets four times a week and shortens the training period by one month - requiring more daily preparation by the students.

The classes do not meet when Purdue University classes are not in session. Graduates wanting to complete their flight training in time to instruct during the following semester will be able to do so with advanced planning and an aggressive schedule.
